Approximately 1000 campers got to hear the Good News of Jesus Christ and to experience living in a community of caring dedicated staff who model the Christian walk. What I find really encouraging is that the kids from our churches are inviting their friends, many of whom have no church home. This is an incredible opportunity to reach into these homes with the Gospel. Only 25% of our campers are from an MB church, while nearly 30% come from no church background at all. Imagine if these kids went home and brought their families to your church.
